

Hamptons Luxury Homes and Telemark to Launch Hamptons Green Alliance

Long Island East End Businesses Committed to Sustainable and Green Building Practices To Join Together to Share Information with Consumers

As with the charter members, each sponsor will represent a unique category of green building materials, products and systems.

“We anticipate that our green alliance will be active in a variety of other ways, including shared advertising, cross marketing activities and joint trade show participation,” said Dalene. He believes that this alliance represents the first such network of its kind.
